


Yoga Day


The purpose of a teacher and various hacks teachers should adapt to educate the students of the upcoming generation so that they can learn efficiently.

Me, books friends forever





The Sports day began with the Aloysian flame being lit and the release of the balloons.



The function ended with a prayer by the Principal Mrs. Seema Tomy.





Pure Mathematics involves the use of pure numbers while applied Mathematics involves quantities such as numerical values and units of measurement. Applied Mathematics is used in practical applications in day-to-day life while pure Mathematics is the study of principles without much practical application. For instance, courses in pure Mathematics can help you enter the field of academics and research. Knowing your career interest can help you make an informed career decision.

Pure Mathematics

Pure Mathematics is abstract and theoretical. It is used to solve problems, find facts and answer questions that do not depend on the world around us, but on the rules of Mathematics itself. If you are an arts or science graduate, then pure Mathematics is easy to learn.

Applied Mathematics

It is better than pure Mathematics because it uses the formulas of pure maths and applies them in the real life. Applied maths tries to model predict, and explain things in the real world. 


VALUE EDUCATION





HOW CAN WE DEVELOPE


'Say no to everything thats not aligned with your essential priorities

Importance Of Hand Gestures in Dance

Most classical dances use multiple gestures to create a performance. They use different gestures to express the core of the story through facial expressions, body movements and through the use of the hands and fingers.

The meaning of mudra (gesture) in Sanskrit is mudamanandangratidadati ('that which gives ultimate joy'). A Mudra is a symbolic hand gesture used in performing arts, and spiritual practice, including yoga, dance and drama. Hand mudras (hasta mudra) are an important in many Indian classical dances. It makes the story easy to understand, when the performer uses appropriate mudras to communicate and express to the audience.

According to the Bharat Natya Shastra, there are 64 hand Mudras and according to AbhinayaDarpan, there are 55 Hand Mudras. The latter very beautifully explains how the dancer expresses oneself through Kathak. As you render a song by singing it, you express the meaning of the song through hand gestures, use your eyes to stir into it the blend of emotions and keep track of the time with your feet.

Broadly speaking there are two main categories under which all the mudras can be segregated.

Asanyukt Hast Mudra – is the mudra that can make by using one hand. Sanyukt Hast Mudra – is the mudra that can make by using both the hands.

Understanding the hasta mudras and executing them correctly is a part ofbuilding yourself as a powerful performer. Each finger in our hand also plays an important role in reciting the story of dance.

The application of mudras to invoke emotions, nature and reality is not limited to dance. In fact, mudras cross the boundary of dance and enter the world of abhinaya (acting), where they perform crucial symbolic, interpretative and poetic functions.






रंगारंग वेशभूषा सहित हिन्दी संवाद प्रतियोगिता कक्षा-तीसरी से पाँचवी







देखभाल करना मेरे लिए बहुत मायने रखता था क्योंकि मेरी माँ की दोस्त (क्लेरी) ने मेरे और मेरे भाई की देखभाल की थी जब मेरी माँ अपनी मास्टर डिग्री पूरी करने में व्यस्त थीं और हमारे पिता इराक में थे। कभी-कभी हमारी मां इतनी व्यस्त रहती थीं कि उनके पास खुद के लिए भी समय नहीं होता था। सुश्री क्लेरी हमेशा हमारी देखभाल करने, खाना पकाने, हमारे स्कूल के काम में सहायता करने, हमारे घर को व्यवस्थित करने और साफ करने, हमें फिल्मों और खेलों में ले जाने के लिए मौजूद थीं। कभी-कभी वह हमें सप्ताहांत के लिए रखती थी। सुश्री क्लेरी ने हमारी देखभाल उसी तरह की जैसे एक माँ अपने बच्चों की करती है। उसने कभी शिकायत नहीं की, सिकोड़ी, तनावग्रस्त, या डगमगाई। उसने अपने पूरे दिल से जिम्मेदारी स्वीकार की। उन्होंने हमारे लिए दूसरी मां के रूप में सेवा की। हम सुश्री क्लेरी से प्यार करते हैं।
